

SCA 2022 Points and Golden Ticket Process

2022 SCA Steak Points Chase

- SCA Steak Points are tracked and recorded by the Head Cook's name. The Head Cook cannot have someone else cook under his/her name, and he/she cannot cook on another team. Each Head Cook must be a current member to receive points for an event.
- The head cook must be a current member to receive points for an event. SCA does not track points for non-members.
- USA Steak Points are awarded to the top ten placing cooks in each steak event. The Cook will receive 1 point for cooking the event, so the top ten would look like this: 1st=11 points, 2nd=10 points, 3rd=9 points, 4th=8 points, 5th=7 points, 6th=6 points, 7th=5 points, 8th=4 points, 9th=3 points, 10th=2 points, and all other participants get 1 point.
- International Steak Points are awarded to the top ten placing cooks in each steak event. 1st=10 points, 2nd=9 points, 3rd=8 points, 4th=7 points, 5th=6 points, 6th=5 points, 7th=4 points, 8th=3 points, 9th=2 points, and 10th=1 points.
- Points may be accumulated at any SCA event in the world, but the points will be applied to your points' chase home base. For example, if you live in Germany and participate in an event in the US, your points will be added to your SCA Europe points chase.
- Any DQ in steak will still earn 1 point for the event since we are blind judging and would not know who it was. (USA only)
- The person with the most SCA Points for the season in each SCA Region will be the 2022 Points Champion of their region.
- USA Tie Breakers: 1st highest number of SCA Steak Points, highest number of 1st place wins, highest per cookoff average.
- International Tie Breakers: 1st highest number of SCA Steak Points, highest number of 1st place wins, most top ten finishes.
- In the event of a total tie, both get the same prize package.
- Winner receives the SCA Points Ring, an automatic entry into the final round of the SCA World Championship and prizes.
- International Regions (SCA Europe, SCA Australia, SCA New Zealand, SCA Asia) must have 15 events in their region to get a Points Champion Ring and an Automatic entry into the Final Round of the SCA World Championship.
- Steak Golden Tickets may only roll down to 10th place.

2022 Ancillary Points Chase

- SCA Ancillary Points are tracked and recorded by the Head Cook's name. The Head Cook cannot have someone else cook under his/her name, and he/she cannot cook on under another cook's name.

- The head cook must be a current member to receive points for an event. SCA does not track points for non-members.
- Each ancillary cook may enter 1 entry per ancillary category at an event.
- SCA Ancillary Points are awarded to the top ten placing cooks in each ancillary event. The top ten would look like this: 1st=10 points, 2nd=9 points, 3rd=8 points, 4th=7 points, 5th=6 points, 6th=5 points, 7th=4 points, 8th=3 points, 9th=2 points, and 10th=1 point.
- Points may be accumulated at any SCA event in the world, but the points will be applied to your points' chase home base. For example, if you live in Germany and participate in an event in the US, your points will be added to your SCA Europe points chase.
- The person with the most SCA Ancillary Points for the season will be the 2022 Ancillary Points Champion for their SCA Region.
- Tie Breakers: 1st highest number of SCA Steak Points, highest number of 1st place wins, most top ten finishes.
- In the event of a total tie, both get the same prize package.
- Winner receives the SCA Ancillary Points Ring, an automatic entry into the final round of the SCA World Championship and prizes.
- International Regions (SCA Europe, SCA Australia, SCA New Zealand, SCA Asia) must have 15 events in their region to get a Points Champion Ring and an Automatic entry into the Final Round of the SCA World Championship.
- Ancillary Golden Tickets may only roll down to 10th place.

Golden Tickets

- A Golden ticket is awarded to the winner of each SCA event. If the winner has already won a Golden ticket it will pass down to the next cook.
- The Golden Ticket cannot be passed down past 10th place for both the steak and ancillary categories.
- If the winner of the event is not a member at the time of their win, they will have until the following Monday at 8AM to become a member.
- You must be a member of the SCA to compete at the SCA World Championship.
- Cooks can only win one golden ticket per season. Golden Ticket are not transferable.

“At Large Bid”

- A Golden Ticket that was not claimed at an event. These are awarded at the end of the season and go to the cooks in the points chase, with the most points, that are not already qualified with a Golden Ticket.

SCA Championship Qualification (Members Only)

There are three ways to qualify for the SCA World Championship.

1. Win a Golden Ticket
2. Win an "At Large Bid"
3. Be a previous SCA World Champion or SCA Legend Award Winner.
